We are happy to have your child registered and planning to attend this year's **Pennsylvania Disciples Camps** program. Qualified volunteers from our churches staff the outdoor ministry program of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Pennsylvania.

Enclosed with this **Camp Confirmation** letter is a copy of the **Camp and Conference Rules**. Please review this page with your camper. We feel a heavy responsibility for the safety of campers while at camp. This raises a concern about what campers bring to camp that may endanger them or other campers. We are mindful of the dignity of the individual camper and his/her right to privacy but need to balance this with the safety of all.

We received your child's health information form with his/her camp registration, if there have been any significant changes, please make the Camp Director aware when you bring your child to camp.

Camp and Conference registration is open from **3:00 – 5:00 pm on Sunday**. **All camps** conclude on **Saturday at 10:00 am**, except Mini Camp, which ends on Wednesday, July 21, at 10:30 AM. If your child must leave early, please make arrangements with the Director when the child is registered, no refund of camp fees will be granted for early departures.

There are times during the week that the children are taken off-site to a nearby recreational facility. A bus, with a licensed driver, is used to transport the children to and from the site. The camp counseling staff accompanies the children on all off-site trips.

Campers, counselors, and staff are required to dress in a manner conducive to a Christian community. The camp director reserves the right to ask any individual in a camp setting to change their clothing.

An offering is taken each week of camp. The offerings we receive at camp this year will go to the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Pennsylvania **Camper Scholarship Fund**.
